

Note about dot.Net versions. On some systems some version of .net will have problem with exe builds using both the managed class library and older DLL. The following needs to be added (or file created) to app.config.

```
<?xml version="1.0" encoding="utf-8" ?>
<configuration>
<startup useLegacyV2RuntimeActivationPolicy="true">
<supportedRuntime version="v4.0"/>
</startup>
</configuration>
```

Some programming languages like C++ don't follow configuration file management and need the have the file copied to target directory, under the project configuration post build events and the following to the command line to create and move the file to the exe working directory. Then add the System.configuration reference to your code.

```
copy app.config "$(TargetPath).config"
```
